<p>For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness, Nor shall evil dwell with You. - Psalm 5:4</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The LORD tests the righteous, But the wicked and the one who loves violence His <u>soul</u> hates. - Psalm 11:5 To declare that the LORD is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him. - Psalm 92:15 <p>IN CONTRAST –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those who are planted in the house of the LORD Shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing, To declare that the LORD is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him. - Psalm 92:12-15

<p>The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity. - Psalm 5:5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boastful - Strong's H1984 - הָלַל hâlal, haw-lal'; to shine; hence, to make a show, to boast; and thus to be (clamorously) foolish; to rave; causatively, to celebrate; also to stultify • Workers - Strong's H6466 - פָּעַל pā'al, paw-al'; a primitive root; to do or make (systematically and habitually), especially to practise:—commit, (evil-) do(-er), make(-r), ordain, work(-er). • Iniquity - Strong's H205 - אָוֵן 'âven, aw-ven'; from an unused root perhaps meaning properly, to pant (hence, to exert oneself, usually in vain; to come to naught); strictly nothingness; also trouble, vanity, wickedness; specifically an idol:—affliction, evil, false, idol, iniquity, mischief, mourners(-ing), naught, sorrow, unjust, unrighteous, vain, vanity, wicked(-ness) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled; My steps had nearly slipped. But You, O God, shall bring them down to the pit of destruction; Bloodthirsty and deceitful men shall not live out half their days; But I will trust in You. - Psalm 55:22-23 • "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death." - Revelation 21:8 • But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie. - Revelation 22:15

For you are like graves which are not seen, and the men who walk over them are not aware of them." - Luke 11:44 • "Their throat is an open tomb; With their tongues they have practiced deceit"; "The poison of asps is under their lips"; - Romans 3:13 • They sharpen their tongues like a serpent; The poison of asps is under their lips.
